

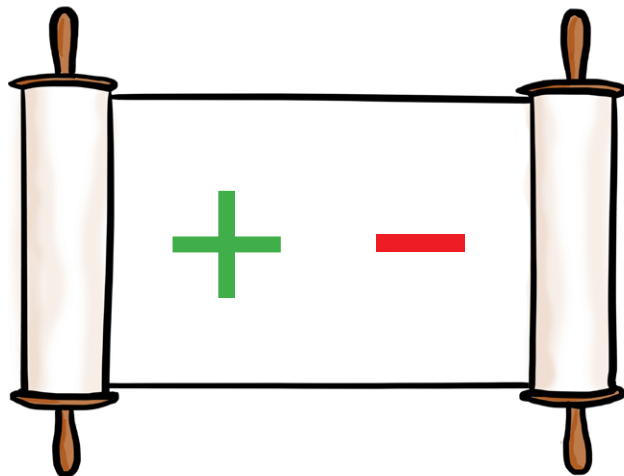
# ETGAR Weekly Challenge
