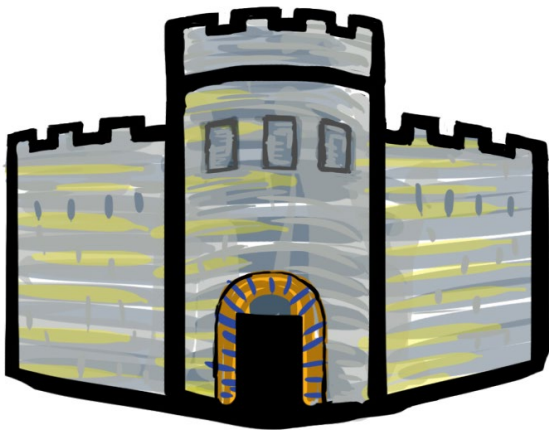


# ETGAR Weekly Challenge

וַיֹּאמֶר אֶל-לָבָן, מַה-זֹּאת עָשִׂיתָ לִּי--  
הֲלֹא בְרַחֵל עַבְדָּתִי עִמָּךְ, וְלָמָּה רָמִיתָנִי.

“And *Ya’akov* said to *Lavan*, ‘What have you done to me? Did I not serve you for *Rachel*? Why have you tricked me?’  
(*Bereishit* 29:25)

- *Lavan* tricked *Ya’akov* into marrying *Leah*. The Rabbis say that God was punishing *Ya’akov* ‘measure for measure’. What do you think they mean?
- Why do you think *Leah* agreed to the deception?
- Have you ever done something wrong because you thought it was the right thing to do?
