

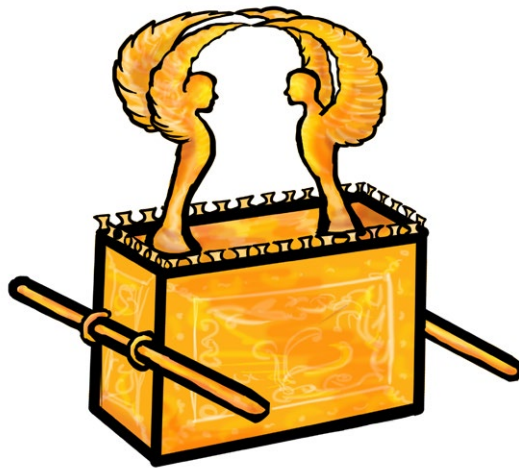

דַּבֵּר אֶל-בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל, וְיִקְחוּ-לִי תְרוּמָה: מֵאֵת כָּל-אִישׁ אֲשֶׁר יִדְבְּנוּ לְבוֹ ... וַעֲשׂוּ לִי, מִקְדָּשׁ; וְשִׁכַנְתִּי, בְּתוֹכְכֶם  
“Speak to the children of Israel that they take for Me an offering, of every man whose heart makes him willing ... and let them make a sanctuary for Me so that I may dwell among them.” (*Shemot* 25:2,8)
